The board through its attorney noted that just because an advertisement is **"misleading and fails to disclose all the relevant facts,"** it does not necessarily come under OEC regulation.

As a board member, I would:


1) Insist on transparency.

Kettering's per pupil expense (blue line) exceeds inflation. This year Kettering will spend over **\$11,200** on each student.

Because Kettering's total tax base (green line) is decreasing, we must be taxed at a higher effective rate (gold line) to raise the same revenue.

The 6.9 mill renewal levy, approved in May, last year had an effective rate of 6.13 mills. This year the rate is 6.16 mills. Because Kettering's tax base is decreasing, this effective rate will continue to rise.
